COMPETITION RULES

- 1. One entry per class per prefix.
- 2. Class 1 Top Females 6 animals to be put forward regardless of herd size.
- 3. Class 8 Family Group should consist of at least 3 animals related no further back than the granddam. For Example: Dam & 2 Daughters or 3 Maternal Sisters or 3 Generations
- 4. Class 9 Iron Grandma must have produced over 80tonnes
- 5. Class 10 Open to all Border & Lakeland HYB members. No age restriction on the heifers other than they must be unserved. Entry for this class is free of charge (& no prize money). The class will be spilt by age of heifers dependent upon entries.
- 6. Best Red & White animal will be judges choice from animals entered in classes 1 10
- 7. Class 11 Entry for this class is free of charge

NOTE TO ALL MEMBERS

The judges schedule will be published in advance of the competition. Club members are encouraged to follow the route and view the competition entries on farm (with the permission of entrants). We respectfully ask that you adhere to recommended bio-security rules when visiting farms.
